

Informational notice to clients

To prevent personal injury or infection, please be aware of these important requirements from **Rule R392-702 Cosmetology Facility Sanitation:**

- 1 Nail technicians must wash hands with soap and water before performing any nail technology services.
- 2 Single-use implements—including nail files, buffer blocks, sponges, and cotton—can only be used on a single client and cannot be reused.
- 3 Multi-use implements or tools must be cleaned, rinsed, and disinfected before use on a new client.
- 4 UV sterilizers or light boxes are not infection control devices and cannot be used as a replacement for manual washing, rinsing, and disinfection procedures.
- 5 Each whirlpool foot spa must be drained, cleaned, and circulated with disinfectant before use on a new client. Except in the case of a non-circulating foot bath with a removable liner when the liner is replaced after each use.
- 6 Only a licensed master esthetician is authorized to use a razor-type callus shaver designed and intended to cut or shave growths of skins. You can ask to see the license.
