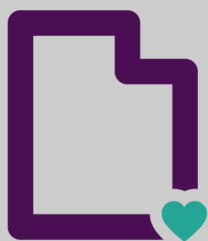

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Chlamydia

What is chlamydia?

- Chlamydia is a sexually transmitted infection that can infect anyone

How is chlamydia spread?

- Through vaginal, oral, or anal sexual contact
- Untreated mothers can pass infections to newborns during childbirth
- Can be spread even when there are no symptoms

Signs and symptoms of chlamydia

Most people do not have signs or symptoms. If left untreated, chlamydia can cause permanent damage and can increase a person's chances of getting or spreading HIV.

- Female symptoms
 - * White, clear, or cloudy vaginal discharge
 - * Pain or burning sensation while urinating
 - * Pain in lower abdomen
 - * Can lead to pre-term births in pregnant women and severe eye infections and pneumonia in newborns
- Male symptoms
 - * White, clear, or cloudy discharge from penis
 - * Burning sensation while urinating
 - * Swelling or soreness at the head of the penis
 - * Swelling in the testicles
- Chlamydia in the rectum can cause rectal discharge and bleeding

Who is most at risk?

- Any sexually active person
- Those with new or multiple sex partners
- Not using a condom or incorrect condom use

How is chlamydia diagnosed?

- Urine sample
- Chlamydia is a site-specific infection which means testing will need to occur in the sites that are exposed sexually (people who receive anal sex will need a rectal swab to be adequately tested)

Is chlamydia treatable?

- Yes, with antibiotics

Gonorrhea

What is gonorrhea?

- Gonorrhea is a sexually transmitted infection that can infect anyone

How is gonorrhea spread?

- Through vaginal, oral, or anal sexual contact
- Untreated mothers can pass infections to newborns during childbirth
- Can be spread even when there are no symptoms

Signs and symptoms of gonorrhea

Most people do not have signs or symptoms. Untreated gonorrhea can cause permanent damage and can increase a person's chances of getting or spreading HIV.

- Female symptoms
 - * Green, yellow, or gray vaginal discharge
 - * Pain or burning sensation while urinating
 - * Bleeding between menstrual cycles
 - * Pregnant women can pass the infection to the unborn baby which can cause blindness, joint infection, or a life-threatening blood infection in the newborn
- Male symptoms
 - * Green, yellow, or gray discharge from penis
 - * Burning sensation while urinating
 - * Swelling or soreness at the head of the penis
 - * Swelling in the testicles
- Can spread to the blood stream, causing pain throughout the body, and can be life threatening.

Who is most at risk?

- Any sexually active person
- Those with new or multiple sex partners
- Not using a condom or using it wrong

How is gonorrhea diagnosed?

- Urine sample
- Gonorrhea is a site-specific infection which means testing will need to occur in the sites that are exposed sexually (people who receive anal sex will need a rectal swab to be adequately tested)

Is gonorrhea treatable?

- Yes, with antibiotics

Syphilis

What is syphilis?

- Syphilis is a sexually transmitted infection that can infect anyone
- Untreated syphilis can cause serious health problems and even death
- Syphilis is divided into stages with different signs and symptoms

How is syphilis spread?

- Direct contact with syphilis sores, mucous membranes, and other bodily fluids during vaginal, oral, or anal sexual contact
- Pregnant women can also spread syphilis to their infant in the womb

Signs and symptoms of syphilis

- Primary syphilis
 - * Painless sore at original site of infection
- Secondary syphilis
 - * Skin rash, swollen lymph nodes, or fever
- Early non-primary non-secondary syphilis
 - * No primary or secondary signs or symptoms, but infection happened in the past year
- Late/unknown duration syphilis
 - * No primary or secondary signs or symptoms, and it is unknown when infection happened, or it happened more than a year ago
- Neurosyphilis
 - * Headache, problems with thinking, hearing loss, blurry vision, etc.
 - * Neurosyphilis can occur at any stage of syphilis

Who is most at risk?

- Men who have sex with men (MSM)
- People who trade sex for money or other goods
- Those with new or multiple sex partners
- Not using a condom or using it wrong

How is syphilis diagnosed?

- Blood sample or sample from syphilis sore

Is syphilis treatable?

- Yes, with antibiotics, but sometimes damage can be permanent

Herpes

What is herpes?

- Herpes is a sexually transmitted infection that can infect anyone

How is herpes spread?

- Skin-to-skin sexual contact with someone who has herpes
- Pregnant women can spread herpes to their unborn child in the womb or to a newborn during childbirth
- Can be spread even when there are no symptoms

Signs and symptoms of herpes

- Painful blisters or pimple-like sores on or around the genitals, anus, or mouth
- Flu-like symptoms when sores are present
- Sores can come back several times in a year
- Pregnant women may deliver their baby early or herpes may cause a miscarriage
- Can cause a deadly infection in an unborn child

Who is most at risk?

- People with multiple sexual partners

How is herpes diagnosed?

- Visual exam
- Sample from sores
- Blood sample

Is herpes treatable?

- No, but there are treatments for symptoms
- Some medicine can prevent sores or make them go away faster
- Daily treatment can reduce the risk of passing herpes to a partner

Hepatitis C

What is hepatitis C?

- Hepatitis C is a liver disease caused by the hepatitis C virus (HCV)
- It can damage the liver over time

How is HCV spread?

- Sharing drug-injection equipment
- During pregnancy or childbirth when the mother has HCV
- Unregulated tattoos or body piercings
- Sexual contact with someone with HCV
- Sharing personal items contaminated with infected blood (razors, nail clippers, toothbrushes)
- Blood transfusions and organ transplants before 1992

Signs and symptoms of HCV

Many people do not have signs or symptoms. People with chronic HCV can live for years without symptoms or feeling sick. When symptoms appear with chronic HCV, they often indicate advanced liver disease. Symptoms can include:

- * Fatigue
- * Nausea
- * Abdominal pain
- * Dark-colored urine
- * Yellow discoloration in the skin and eyes (jaundice)
- * Fever
- * Muscle and joint pains

Who is most at risk?

- People who currently inject drugs or those who have injected drugs
- People with known exposures to HCV
- People living with HIV
- Healthcare workers who are frequently exposed to blood
- People who received transfusions or organ transplants before 1992
- Children born to a mother with HCV

How is HCV diagnosed?

- Blood sample

Is HCV treatable?

- Yes, treatments are available that can cure most people with HCV in 8–12 weeks.

HIV/AIDS

What is human immunodeficiency virus (HIV)?

- HIV is a virus which can lead to acquired immunodeficiency syndrome (AIDS) if untreated
- HIV attacks the immune system which helps the body fight off infections

How is HIV spread?

- HIV is spread when the blood, semen, pre-seminal fluid, rectal fluids, vaginal fluids, and/or breast milk of a person who has HIV comes in contact with a mucous membrane, or the broken skin of an uninfected person
- It can also be spread directly into the blood stream (needle/syringe sharing, mother to baby)

Signs and symptoms of HIV

- Stage 1: acute HIV infection
 - * People may experience flu-like symptoms within 2–4 weeks after infection
- Stage 2: clinical latency (HIV inactivity or dormancy)
 - * No symptoms but can still transmit to others
 - * Those on medical treatments for HIV can stay in this stage for decades and are much less likely to transmit HIV to others
- Stage 3: acquired immunodeficiency syndrome (AIDS)
 - * People with AIDS have a weakened immune system which can increase the chance of getting a number of severe illnesses called opportunistic illnesses
 - * Chills, fever, swollen lymph glands, weakness, and weight loss

Who is most at risk?

- Men who have sex with men (MSM)
- People who inject drugs

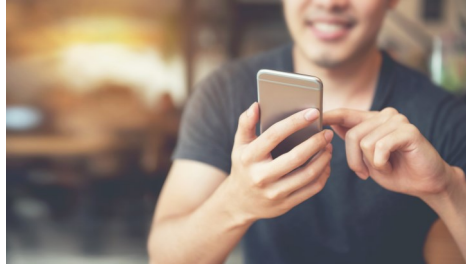
How is HIV diagnosed?

- Blood sample or oral swab

Is HIV treatable?

- While no effective cure exists, HIV can be controlled with proper medical care

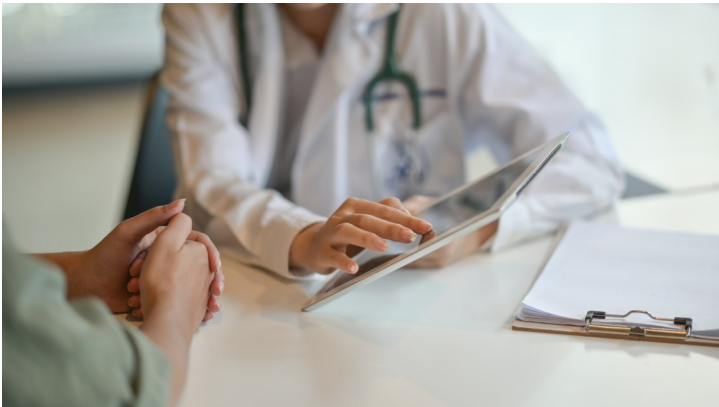

But did you know that **you may be able to get treatment for your partner, too?**

Talk to your doctor. They may be able to give you medicine or a prescription for your partner — even without seeing them. This is called **expedited partner therapy (EPT)** or patient-delivered partner therapy (PDPT), and it's available in most states.
